CHURCH MEETING

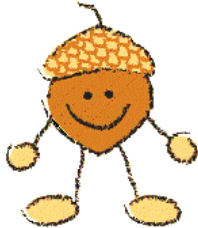

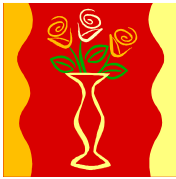


THANK YOU to all the **EXPLODE** leaders and helpers for all their hard work over the last few months. We hope you all enjoy a well-earned break over the summer ☺.
