PRAYER - Tragedy in Uganda (26.02.09)

Join us in praying for Afghanistan where the maternal mortality rate (MMR) is the second highest in the world, where death in childbirth is the highest cause of deaths among women. That can be compared to America (and the UK is almost the same) where 13 in every 100,000 die. In Afghanistan, out of 100,000 pregnant women 1,600 of them die. There are many reasons for these horrific figures, chief of which is probably 20 years of continual war.

During the Taliban era female doctors were forbidden from working and male family members often prohibited female relatives from being examined by male doctors. We thank God that since the fall of the Taliban in 2001 there has been an improvement in facilities for women giving birth, and midwives are being trained. However these improvements mostly benefit women in the cities. In the more remote places facilities are still very limited. Let us pray for these especially then, that they would know a greater measure of divine intervention in seemingly hopeless situations.
