## NEWS AND PRAYERS

**Great potential in Peru** A small group of Christian students in south eastern Peru are sacrificing their Sunday sleep-ins to run a new children's club with BMS World Mission's Scott and Anjanette Williamson.



Scott said the foundations are there for the group to grow and admits their work with the students is really only just beginning to take off but explained the outreach is a central part of that.

He said: "Typically, we started late and many who said they would come didn't but hopefully, as word gets around, more will come. Veronica and Maxi, the students who led the group with us, did brilliantly and the children had a lot of fun together - they absolutely loved the parachute!"

### Taking off



Scott and Anjanette and their two children, Jess and Sam, moved to Cusco in March after language study in Arequipa since last September. It is a city of 350,000 people and a popular tourist destination, best-known for being the historic capital of the Inca Empire. It is also the spot on Earth with the highest ultraviolet light level!

He said: "One year ago a small group of Baptist students met together for prayer and Bible study as there is no official Peruvian Baptist Convention church here. The group of ten met on and off as they really wanted to start to

reach out to local children they often saw playing in the street. Their aim was to run midweek activities such as a chess and film club, Bible study and maybe a football game".

### Huge potential

The group gather on Sunday afternoons for worship and prayer. Scott and Anjanette are leading a course to enable them to share their faith with friends.

Scott who is very excited by the future of the group said: "The students will ultimately be responsible for running the different activities and there is huge potential. It's exciting to work with young believers.

### Pray for us that:

- That more children will come to the Sunday morning club in future weeks.
- That Scott, Anjanette and the students will be able to share God's love with local children and their parents - and for good communication skills!
- For the four Peruvian gap year workers from the Convention's Radical Peru programme who arrive in August to support the work for three months.
- For a new café church project which the Williamsons are planning.
