NEWS FROM BMS MISSION

Dozens of Baptist ministers made a public re-commitment to send people from their churches to go for overseas mission during the Baptist Assembly 2009 in Bournemouth (1-4 May).

Church leaders came to the front of the main stage in response to a plea for more long-term overseas mission workers. The heartfelt appeal came from BMS World Mission's general director David Kerrigan and Daveen Wilson, a BMS mission worker in Brazil, who highlighted the great need for more UK Christians to go and share the gospel around the world.

The Baptist Assembly is on a green journey with the aim of becoming carbon-neutral in its impact in just a few years' time.

This journey started in Bournemouth with a number of new environmental initiatives at the Assembly.

As well as fairly-traded Freetset jute bags and extensive recycling points, there was also an opportunity for delegates to offset the CO₂ they emitted in travelling to and from the Assembly.

The carbon offset touch-screen proved a success with 1,101 people taking part across the weekend, meaning 40,102kg of carbon was offset, and over £500 donated for Climate Stewards' tree-planting and renewable energy initiatives in places such as Ghana. This action led to discussions and conversations between delegates and those leading this initiative, and many were keen to take the ideas back to their churches after the Assembly.
