Alan Goldring is visiting WBC on Feb. 1st to talk about the '*Mission Aviation Fellowship*'. (MAF). This is a Christian organisation, which flies light aircraft into developing countries in remote areas to bring much needed help. It may be on a spiritual level, plus transporting missionaries, or bringing medical help and medicines. They may be engaged in the emergency evacuation of injured or sick people needing urgent hospital care. MAF may be the only practical link to the outside world for some communities who rely on them for material help, in food, pots and pans and the daily utensils of everyday life. MAF operate in 37 countries and have 67 bases of operation throughout the world. MAF fly 130 Aircraft mainly in South and Central America, Africa, SE Asia and various other Asian Countries."
