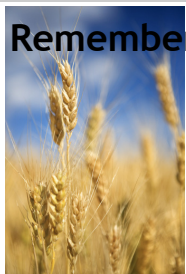

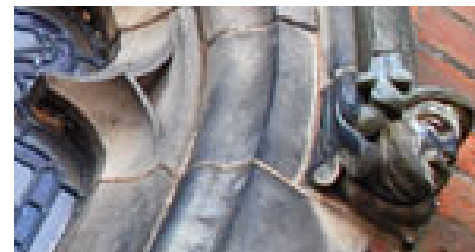
We pray you will be blessed as you worship and praise our great and mighty God. If you need prayer, please do ask.

However, the two are still in jail. The

wheels of justice are slow and rusty in Nepal. The major Hindu festival of Dashain is coming up and it looks like it will be several months still before they are released.

Please pray that they will be released before the festival starts, and that they will know God's presence and encouragement in their situation.

Around one year ago a young couple had an argument and the wife left her husband to go back to her parents' house. Her parents were not happy to see her and sent her back to her husband, who is a believer. That night the girl committed suicide.

A proper investigation was done at the time with an autopsy and everyone agreed it was suicide. One year later, the parents of the girl went to an organisation for women's rights and accused the girl's husband and the local pastor's wife of murdering their daughter.

The two were promptly thrown in prison, awaiting a formal investigation and trial. That was three months ago.

The pastor's wife is a dynamic woman, who has used her time in prison to share with those around her, including a woman [who left a bomb in a Catholic church several months ago, killing several people](#). She is leading a prison fellowship of 60 women now!

The girl's family have since admitted that they were just angry

Do your relationships need healing? With God, all things are possible.

Is there sickness in you body? With God, all things are possible!

As you meditate on God's power, He will work in your life, and you will step forward into that place of victory He has in store for you.

Heavenly Father, thank You for making a way where there seems to be no way. I choose to trust You, and I believe that all things are possible! Show me Your power today. Work through me to encourage those around me to trust You more. In Jesus' Name. Amen.
