PRAYER - Australia fires & New York state plane crash

Melbourne - More than 5,000 people have been made homeless and almost 2,000 homes destroyed when the worst fires in the country's history tore through towns in south-eastern Victoria state this week. Many have been killed and the total number is not yet clear.

A Red Cross spokeswoman said almost 66 million dollars had been raised for the relief fund through public donations, but "many millions more" had been pledged through the telethon and corporate and government donations. Most of all we need to pray for the people and families involved in this tragic incident.

Buffalo, New York. Pray also for those involved in the tragic loss of life, when an aeroplane carrying 48 people crash early hours of Friday morning this week. The loss of all crew and passengers, plus a person killed on the ground in the close knit community.
