Baptists in Zimbabwe have formed an association running vitally important feeding programmes for thousands of families.

China There is no doubt that God is at work in China. China has experienced the fastest growing church movement in history. Approximately 20,000 people become Christians in China every day. But the persecution is not over. Christians are still regularly arrested and sent to prisons and labour camps. All churches are required to register with the government, and those that refuse are considered subversive. Yet those who register are forced to comply with government-approved pastors and doctrine, which many times contradict correct biblical teaching.
