## PRAYER - Tragedy in Uganda (17.02.09)

A BMS Action Team in Uganda since Oct 2008, worked with a small church in the town of Busembetia in the south of the country. On Sun 15 Feb, a baptismal service for some Ugandan young people from the church was held at a nearby pond. The Action Team was involved in this and took turns to help Pastor Ronald with the baptisms.

After the service, while waiting to board the truck to take them back to Busembetia, it was realised that four young Ugandan men were missing. The bodies of Geoffrey, Fred, Kenneth and Moses were discovered in water and despite efforts to resuscitate them, they did not live. It is unclear exactly what, why, how they ended up in the water.

Pastor Ronald is being held by the police, partly for his own safety as tensions are high. The police are likely to charge him. The Action Team have been taken to Kampala for rest, help and support. Andrew North, the Regional Secretary for Africa, is travelling out to Uganda to be with the team.
