Imagine moving your local school, lock, stock and barrel to new premises - by Land Rover! For BMS teacher Sarah Pryor at the Surkhet Primary Study Centre (PSC), in mid-west of Nepal, it was a reality. Sarah said that when she was told to leave because the landlord had sold the house, her heart sank, for she knew that to find another place would be difficult, especially when there are no adverts or estate agents where she is.

God moves in mysterious ways, because while walking her dog, she got talking with a man who mentioned that his relative wanted to let his house. People still lived in the house but moved next door. Plans were drawn for work to be done prior to the move. Two weeks after the contract was signed the work hadn't begun and it didn't look like it would be either.

On the last day of the old school, everyone was caught up enthusiastically with taping boxes of equipment and school stuff and off they went with the land-rover piled high overloaded! When they arrived at their new place, the previous tenants had gone, the painting had been done, but the windows were missing! Our missionary rep Alan Barker helped move them in five huge land-rover and trailer loads. At the end of that day they gave thanks for the physical strength they needed and for the physical, emotional and spiritual strength God will give them as they rebuild the new Surkhet Primary Study Centre.
