It didn't offer us the opportunity to mingle with the families like we'd hoped it would, but we were able to speak to them in passing, and see their children enjoying learning about God's world.

Back at WBC, as we relax into our routines and get to know the families more, we are sad to realise that some of the children who we've known for so long are with us for their final weeks, as they will be going to pre-school in the autumn instead of coming to play with us. We pray for all the children and families every week, and we always know that they are only with us for a short time - and so we pray that the time we've had together will influence and stay with them and their parents for all their lives. The spaces they leave are being quickly filled with children who weren't even thought of when our big kids first came - on Monday we had five new families join the other 36 families who were already with us, to play, eat yoghurts, and make springy snakes in the activity room.
