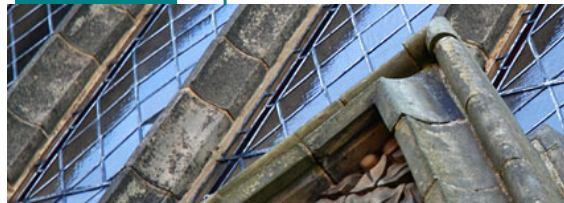

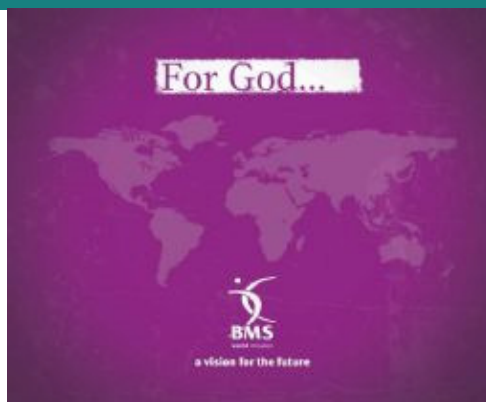
BMS vision document – ‘For God...’

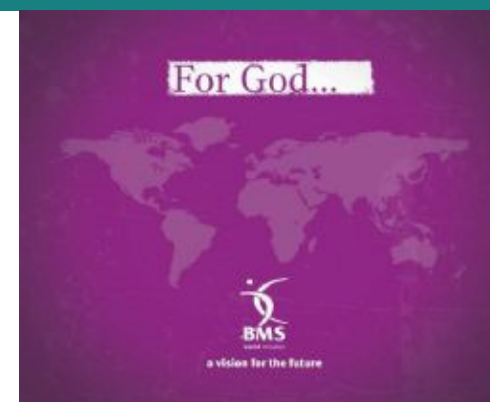
