## Home from Home



Last Autumn we ran Home from Home as a new venture on Wednesday and Thursday afternoon, in an attempt to support those who may be facing the effects of increased energy costs. As a result of this we have continued to meet on the second and fourth Thursday of each month. While the kitchen works are going on we will not be meeting, but hope to start again on either 14<sup>th</sup> or 28<sup>th</sup> September, assuming all the works to the kitchen are complete. If you would like to come along and share in this group, you will receive a very warm welcome. We meet from 1.30p.m. - 4.30p.m. During the autumn/winter months (November to March) our aim is to provide a warm space in the church for everybody where they can simply come, meet with other people, play board games, do puzzles, read the newspaper, chat and enjoy tea/coffee and biscuits and warm snacks, possibly meeting each Thursday, if we have enough volunteers. If you can help please let Cathy know.

#### August Prayer Focus:

At WBC, we work with the Norwich Foodbank, which is part of the Trussell Trust. There is now a table in the lounge during Roots on Fridays that is reserved for the Foodbank and clients are directed there if they have need. The volunteers are from across the town and give out pre-packed boxes and bags of food and essentials. There has been a noticeable increase in people needing access to the Foodbank. The number of parcels provided nationally by the Trussell Trust between April 2022 - March 2023 is more than double the amount distributed by food banks in the same period five years ago.

An important part of the ministry of Roots Community Café is the 'Pay it Forward' board, which is frequently used by visitors to the café.

The Catholic Church in Wymondham (Our Lady and St Thomas of Canterbury RC Church) also operates a Foodbank, with food parcels and a Community Fridge, on Tuesdays and Saturdays, as part of its Community Outreach Project. The foodbank currently serves about 70 households in and around Wymondham. The project also supplies Energy Vouchers for those who are struggling with their energy bills.
